## **Academic Policy**

- 1) There should be convener for the test exam with proper seating arrangement and exam related documentation in the respective department.
- 2) Senior Faculty member should be given the teaching load of higher semester
- 3) Experienced faculties and subject teacher on particular topics be assigned as per expertise.
- 4) One mentor teacher is must for at least 15 students. Copy of the mentor nominated must be sent to Dean Academic.

(Type of Mentoring: Professional guidance / Career advancement / Course work specific, Lab specific / Total development).

- 5) Subject teachers are instructed to prepare a detail course file accompanied by teaching scheme, syllabus, notes, extra problems, question bank and assignments to students on each topic cas per que dine of the second states.
- 6) Teaching through DLP should be arranged. Video and online lectures should be arranged.
- 7) Faculties should update themselves with recent trends and applications and orient the students accordingly.
- 8) Faculties should guide the students for their projects properly.
- 9) All departments are instructed to shoot information about student performance to their parents through SMS.
- 10) All the teachers are instructed to upload their teaching plan, work load syllabus on college monitoring system. If teacher remains absent, he/she has to take the extra lecture within the same month.
- 11) Practicals should be taken complete for 02 hours and teachers are instructed to explain the concept, procedures, purpose of the practicals & give viva voce question. Practical subject teacher are advised to take the application oriented practical to the students.
- 12) Faculties should provide knowledge pertaining to subject other than syllabus.
- 13) Faculty should address the problem of the students.
- 14) Continuous Assessment for each practical shall be graded in terms of marks as shown below:-

- 15) Instructions regarding practical related continues assessment:-
  - If student is present on the day of practical, performs and appears for VIVA-VOCE with reasonable answer then he (student) should be given maximum marks.
  - If student remains absent on the day of practical, performs and appears for VIVA-VOCE with reasonable answer in next practical slot, then he (student) marks should be proportionally degraded.
  - The subject teacher should give continuous assessment marks of 1st practical in the next practical slot and the same should be carried till end of all practical's.
  - Sample format for the above Continues assessment of practical is attached for reference.

There will be surprise visit by committee members or Dean Academic along with Principal during practical hours .

- 16) Class coordinators & Individual teachers are instructed to identify strong and weak students and provide assistance accordingly.
- 17) Minimum 48 to 60 lectures must be taken for subjects as per the scheme of R.T.M Nagpur University..
- 18) Deptt. Master time table & time table of each individual staff member with room no./lecture, teaching load of individual teacher must be submitted on 05/07/2015 (one copy to Academic Dean & Principal).
- 19) It is compulsory to teach at least one unit using PPT or OHP. Standard books should be referred for effective teaching and learning.
- 20) Department must organize parent meet, seminar/workshop, industrial visit
- 21) Syllabus coverage report must be submitted at the end of each month.
